Adult Placement Carers provide short term or long term accommodation with support in their own home.

Direct Payments



Direct Payments are for people who have been assessed as needing help from Social Services. People who would like to can arrange and pay for their own care and support services. This is instead of receiving them directly from the local council.



A person must be able to give their consent to receiving direct payments and be able to manage them even if they need help to this on a day-to-day basis.
